Introduction

1. Some Lack Spiritual Sight to Truly “See” Jesus (vv. 11-21)

A. The Pharisees (vv. 11-13)

- i. Questioning Jesus (v. 11)
- ii. Jesus answers and leaves them (vv. 12-13)

B. The Disciples (vv. 14-21)

- i. Slow to grasp spiritual truth (vv. 14-16)
- ii. Jesus questions the disciples (v. 17-21)
 1. Why are you talking about having no bread? (v. 17)
 2. Do you still not see or understand? (v. 17)
 3. Are your hearts hardened? (v. 17; Mk. 6:51-52)
 4. Do you have eyes but fail to see, and ears but fail to hear? (v. 18; Jer. 5:21; Is. 6:9-10)

5. And don't you remember? (v. 18)
6. (After feeding the 5,000), how many basketfuls of pieces did you pick up? (v. 19)
7. (After feeding the 4,000), how many basketfuls of pieces did you pick up? (v. 20)
8. Do you still not understand? (v. 21)

2. Lack of Spiritual Sight Illustrated (vv. 22-26)

- A. A blind man begs for healing (v. 22)
- B. A two-step solution (vv. 23-25; Mk. 8:29)
- C. A command to return home (v. 26)
