## Introduction

**We may live confidently as Christians because of God’s providential work in all things.**

*“God’s works of providence are his most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all his creatures; ordering them, and all their actions, to his own glory<sup>1</sup>”*

## Scene 1: A Hero is Born (vv. 1-8)

**Implication:** Out of death, God brings life.

**Application:** God’s providence is at work in small acts of faithfulness.

## Scene 2: A Hero Fails (vv. 11-22)

**Implication:** Out of brokenness, God brings redemption.

**Application:** God’s providence is at work in our sinful failure.

*“Without the doctrine of providence theology does not touch life.<sup>2</sup>”*

## Scene 3: The True Hero Appears (vv. 23-25)

**Implication:** In the silence, God is working.

**Application:** God’s providence helps us to be content in all circumstances.

Question: What advantage comes from acknowledging God’s...providence?

Answer: “We learn that we are to be patient in adversity, grateful in the midst of blessing, and trust our gracious God and Father for the future, assured that no creature can separate us from His love...”<sup>3</sup>
