Luke 1:46-55

Introduction

1. **Praise God because He is Savior** (v. 46-47)

A. All are in need of a Savior, because all have sinned (Rom. 3:23; 6:23)

B. Christ paid the penalty for our sins (1 Pet. 2:24)

2. **Praise God because He is Gracious** (v. 48)

A. Grace is offered to us through Christ (Titus 2:11)

B. God graciously uses all kinds of people to advance His Kingdom (1 Cor. 1:26-29)

3. **Praise God because He is Mighty, Holy, and Merciful** (v. 49-50)

A. Don't forget how strong God is! (Ex. 4:11-12)

B. His mercy extends from generation to generation (Judg. 2:10-11; Deut. 6:4-7; 2 Tim. 1:5)

A. God's ways are different from the world's

B. Jesus brought massive change to the world's social order (Luke 4:18-19)

A. His promises to Israel
