 - iii. The places of honor are according to the plan and determination of God the Father (v.40; Matt. 20:23)

 - C. Jesus, Suffering Servant (v. 45)
 - i. Powerful "Son of Man" (Dan. 7:13-14)
 - ii. Gave His life as a ransom "for many" (1 Tim. 2:6)
 - iii. Rooted in Isaiah's Suffering Servant passage (Is. 53)
