## Introduction

### 1. **Preparing for the Last Supper** (vv. 12-16)

- A. The significance of Passover (v. 12)
- B. The detailed arrangements (vv. 13-15)
- C. The disciples prepare for the meal (v.16)

### 2. **Betrayal at the Last Supper** (vv.17-21)

- A. A shocking statement (v. 18; Ps. 41:9)
- B. The disciples' response (v. 19)
- C. A shocking statement reiterated (v. 20)
- D. An affirmation of divine sovereignty and human responsibility (v. 21; Ps. 41:9; Is. 53:12)

### 3. Partaking of the Last Supper (Instituting the Lord's Supper) (vv. 22-26)

#### A. The significance of the bread (v. 22)

- i. Symbolizes His body sacrificially given for others (Lk. 22:19; 1 Cor. 11:24)
  
- ii. The Lord's Supper/Communion is an ordinance of the church, a command of Christ ("do this in remembrance of me" - Lk. 22:19; 1 Cor. 11:24)
  
- iii. The bread did *not* literally turn into the body of Christ. Jesus often used figurative language to refer to Himself (I am the gate – Jn. 10:9, the light of the world – Jn. 8:12, the vine – Jn. 15:5, the way – Jn. 14:6)

#### B. The significance of the cup (vv. 23-24)

- i. Recalls the Mosaic Covenant (Ex. 24:8) and the New Covenant (Jer. 31:31,34)
  
- ii. Symbolizes the sacrificial nature of Christ's death, the shedding of His blood (v. 24 - "poured out for many"; Is. 53:12)

#### C. The anticipation of God's Kingdom fully realized (v. 25)

#### D. The conclusion of the Passover meal (v. 26; Ps. 113-118)

**\* *Jesus is the Passover Lamb, who shed His blood for our sins, and instituted the Lord's Supper for us to remember His victorious death.* \***
