Psalm 2

Introduction

- Ps. 2: no named author in OT text, yet attributed to David by Peter & John (Acts 4:25-26)
- Rooted in 2 Samuel 7

1. **The Rebellion** (v. 1-3)

- A. It won't succeed (v. 1)
- B. United in opposition against God's rule (v. 2)
- C. Don't want to be “bound” under God's authority (v. 3)

2. **The Response** (v. 4-6)

- A. Laughing and mocking (v. 4; Ps. 37:12-13)
- B. Angry rebuke (v. 5-6; Ps. 132:13-14)

3. **The Decree** (v. 7-9)

- A. Declaration of a special relationship (v. 7; 2 Sam. 7:14)

B. Invitation & promise of universal reign (v. 8-9)

4. **The Warning and Blessing** (v. 10-12)

A. Be wise and warned (v. 10)

i. Serve the Lord with fear (v. 11; Prov. 1:7)

ii. Kiss the son (v.12)

1. Avoid destruction (v. 12; Ps. 1:6)

B. Blessing to those who submit to the Lord's rule and king (v. 12)

5. **The Ideal – Jesus, the Messiah**

A. Of the family line of David, heir of David's throne (Matt. 1; Lk. 1:32-33)

B. New Testament quotes of Ps. 2 applying to Jesus

i. The Anointed (King/Messiah) (Ps. 2:2 → Acts 4:27)

ii. God's son (applied to resurrection) (Ps:2:7 → Acts 13:32-33)

1. Alluded to at the baptism of Jesus (Matt. 3:17)

iii. The One who will rule over the nations (Ps. 2:8-9 → Rev. 12:5; 19:15-16)

*** Hope in Jesus, God's true Anointed, who will defeat the wicked and reign over all ***
