#### Lost Virtues pt. 3 – Integrity

1 Chronicles 29:17 NLT – I know, my God, that you examine our hearts and rejoice when you find integrity there.

#### **Benefits of Integrity**

 $\sqrt{}$  You can walk closely with <u>God</u>.

Psalm 15:1-2 NLT – Who may worship in your sanctuary, LORD? Who may enter your presence on your holy hill? <sup>2</sup>Those who lead blameless lives and do what is right, speaking the truth from sincere hearts.

## $\sqrt{}$ You have a built-in <u>guide</u>.

Proverbs 11:3 NIV – The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity.

## $\sqrt{}$ You have consistent <u>peace</u> in your heart.

Proverbs 10:9 CSB – The one who lives with integrity lives securely, but whoever perverts his ways will be found out.

## $\sqrt{}$ You gain trust, respect, honor, and <u>influence</u>.

Nehemiah 7:2 NIV – I put in charge of Jerusalem my brother Hanani, along with Hananiah the commander of the citadel, because he was a man of integrity and feared God more than most people do.

# For the Christian, integrity is acting true to nature – being who you really are – a <u>child</u> of God and a citizen of <u>heaven</u>.

#### **How Develop Integrity**

1. Train your heart to <u>love</u> what Jesus <u>loves</u>.

Colossians 3:1 NIV – Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, <u>set your hearts</u> on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

## 2. Train your brain to think like Jesus thinks.

Colossians 3:2 NIV – Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

## 3. Train your character to be like Jesus's character.

Colossians 3:12-14 NIV – Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.<sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
