- -- David understood his own messiness and sinfulness
- ¹⁰ He does not punish us for all our sins; he does not deal harshly with us, as we deserve.
- ¹¹ For his unfailing love toward those who fear him is as great as the height of the heavens above the earth.
- ¹² He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west.
