Rev 2: <sup>4</sup> But I have this against you: You have abandoned the love you had at first.

-- Many are Committed quitters

--Obviously, there may be reasons or excuses for walking away

## Questions to consider!

I. Have you been saved?

I John 2:19 These people left our churches, but they never really belonged with us; otherwise they would have stayed with us. When they left, it proved that they did not belong with us.

II. How often do you pray?

I Thess 5:17 pray continually,

III. How often do you confess your sins?

Sin stifles our relationship with the Lord

Ephesians 4:30And don't grieve God's Holy Spirit. You were sealed by him [a] for the day of redemption.

Unconfessed sin is an open invitation to the demonic in our lives
