

Truth Telling and Promise Keeping

James 5: ¹² But most of all, my brothers and sisters, never take an oath, by heaven or earth or anything else. Just say a simple yes or no, so that you will not sin and be condemned.

I. As believers we are not prohibited from taking an oath

Joshua 2: ¹⁷ Now the men had said to her, "This oath you made us swear will not be binding on us

I Sam 20: ³ But David took an oath and said, "Your father knows very well that I have found favor in your eyes, and he has said to himself, 'Jonathan must not know this or he will be grieved.' Yet as surely as the LORD lives and as you live, there is only a step between me and death."

Matt 26: ⁶³ The high priest said to him, "I charge you under oath by the living God: Tell us if you are the Messiah, the Son of God."

Rom 1: ⁹ God, whom I serve in my spirit in preaching the gospel of his Son, is my witness how constantly I remember you

II. As believers we must tell the truth

Matthew 23:16-22 Woe to you, blind guides! You say, 'If anyone swears by the temple, it means nothing; but anyone who swears by the gold of the temple is bound by that oath.' ¹⁷ You blind fools! Which is greater: the gold, or the temple that makes the gold sacred? ¹⁸ You also say, 'If anyone swears by the altar, it means nothing; but anyone who swears by the gift on the altar is bound by that oath.' ¹⁹ You blind men! Which is greater: the gift, or the altar that makes the gift sacred? ²⁰ Therefore, anyone who swears by the altar swears by it and by everything on it. ²¹ And anyone who swears by the temple swears by it and by the one who dwells in it. ²² And anyone who swears by heaven swears by God's throne and by the one who sits on it.

Eph 4:15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ., **25** Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body.
