# THE PROBLEM

- Church was growing rapidly
- Greek (Hellenistic) Jews complained about their widows being neglected

#### THE SOLUTION

- Seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and wisdom
- Chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and 6 other guys
- Laid hands on them

# THE RESULT OF THEIR SERVICE

- The word of God spread,
- The disciples increased greatly in number
- A large group of priests became obedient to the faith

# THE SERMON

- Stephen recounts the history and rebellion of Israel
- In v.51 calls out Jews for resisting the Holy Spirit
- v.52 The final straw he says Jesus is God

# THE REACTION

- Gnashed their teeth
- V. 55 Sees into heaven and sees Jesus at the right hand of God
- Yelled, covered their ears, and rushed him

- Dragged out of the city and Stoned
- Saul (Paul) held the coats
- Stephen commends his spirit to God
- Asks for their forgiveness
- He died

1 Saul agreed with putting him to death. On that day a severe persecution broke out against the church in Jerusalem, and all except the apostles were scattered throughout the land of Judea and Samaria.

2 Devout men buried Stephen and mourned deeply over him.

3 Saul, however, was ravaging the church. He would enter house after house, drag off men and women, and put them in prison.

#### GOSPEL WENT TO THE GENTILES

# PAUL'S SUFFERING ADVANCED THE GOSPEL

12 Now I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that what has happened to me has actually advanced the gospel,

PHILIPPIANS 1:12

- AD 64 Nero persecuted the faith with horrific means
- AD 303-311 Diocletian perpetrated the last major persecution of Christians and the church grew like wildfire

 17th Century - Japan caused Christians to worship in Secret until the 1800's when it finally became legal

#### 20th Century -

- China, one of the largest underground churches of the time
- Dietrich Bonhoeffer in WWII spent his fortune and his life trying to free the world of Adolph Hitler
- MLK Jr's campaign of non-violence against slavery cost him his life

#### Today

• Iran has the fastest-growing church on earth in a country where being a Christian will cost you everything, even your life. Gang members face severe physical beatings in order to follow Jesus and give up their lifestyle
