The Story of Potiphar's Wife		
So Potiphar gave Joseph complete administrative responsibility over everything he owned. With Joseph there, he didn't worry about a thing—except what kind of food to eat! Genesis 39:6a		
Joseph was a very handsome and well-built young man, and Potiphar's wife soon began to look at him lustfully. "Come and sleep with me," she demanded.  Genesis 39:6b-7		
But Joseph refused. "Look," he told her, "my master trusts me with everything in his entire household.  Genesis 39:8		
No one here has more authority than I do. He has held back nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How could I do such a wicked thing? It would be a great sin against God." Genesis 39:9
