There is good news!

B. How can we avoid losing a generation from faith?

We can.....Love our spouse!

Eph 5: <sup>22</sup> Wives, submit<sup>[e]</sup> to your husbands as to the Lord, <sup>23</sup> because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup> Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything. <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her

<sup>33</sup> To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband.

We can.....Commit ourselves to discipleship

Duet 6: <sup>4</sup> “Listen, Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>5</sup> Love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. <sup>6</sup> These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. <sup>7</sup> Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup> Bind them as a sign on your hand and let them be a symbol<sup>[b]</sup> on your forehead.<sup>[c]</sup> <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your city gates.

We can..... admit our failures

James 5:<sup>16</sup> Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed.

We can.....Take their questions!

Acts 17: <sup>10</sup> As soon as it was night, the brothers and sisters sent Paul and Silas away to Berea. Upon arrival, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. <sup>11</sup> The people here were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, since they received the word with eagerness and examined<sup>[a]</sup> the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

We can....Pay attention to their influencers.
