Saul and the men of Israel gathered and camped in the Valley of Elah; then they lined up in battle formation to face the Philistines.

The Philistines were standing on one hill, and the Israelites were standing on another hill with a ravine between them.	
1 Samuel 17:3	
Then a champion named Goliath, from Gath, came out from the Philistine camp. He was nine feet, nine inches tall.	
2 Samuel 17:4	
and wore a bronze helmet and bronze scale armor that weighed one hundred twenty-five pounds. 2 Samuel 17:5	
There was bronze armor on his shins, and a bronze javelin was slung between his shoulders.2 Samuel 17:6

if I win against him and kill him, then you will be our servants and serve

The Philistine came closer and closer to David, with the shield-bearer in	
front of him. 2 Samuel 17:41	
When the Philistine looked and saw David, he despised him because he	
was just a youth, healthy and handsome. 2 Samuel 17:42	
He said to David, "Am I a dog that you come against me with sticks?"	
Then he cursed David by his gods. 2 Samuel 17:43	
Come here," the Philistine called to David, "and I'll give your flesh to the	
birds of the sky and the wild beasts!" 2 Samuel 17:44	
David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with a sword, spear,	
and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD of Armies, the	
God of the ranks of Israel—you have defied him. 2 Samuel 17:45	
Today, the LORD will hand you over to me. Today, I'll strike you down,	
remove your head, and give the corpses of the Philistine camp to the	·
birds of the sky and the wild creatures of the earth. Then all the world will

When the Philistine started forward to attack him, David ran quickly to the	
battle line to meet the Philistine. 2 Samuel 17:48	

David put his hand in the bag, took out a stone, slung it, and hit the	
Philistine on his forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell	
facedown to the ground. 2 Samuel 17:49	
David defeated the Philistine with a sling and a stone. David overpowered	
the Philistine and killed him without having a sword.
