II. Be humble all the time!

---Clothe...cover yourself

---Humility.... Self abasement/lowliness of mind.

John 13: <sup>6</sup> He came to Simon Peter, who asked him, "Lord, are you going to wash my feet?"

<sup>7</sup> Jesus answered him, "What I'm doing you don't realize now, but afterward you will understand."

<sup>8</sup> "You will never wash my feet," Peter said.

Jesus replied, "If I don't wash you, you have no part with me."

<sup>9</sup> Simon Peter said to him, "Lord, not only my feet, but also my hands and my head."

II Cor 12:<sup>7</sup> especially because of the extraordinary revelations. Therefore, so that I would not exalt myself, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to torment me so that I would not exalt myself.

---There is the promise of assistance when we humble ourselves.

III. "Cast" because he cares!

---Cast....to throw something on someone else

IV. Pay attention to yourself, surroundings, and the devil!

<sup>8</sup> Be sober-minded, be alert. Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour. <sup>9</sup> Resist him, firm in the faith, knowing that the same kind of sufferings are being experienced by your fellow believers throughout the world.

---Be sober minded means do not be intoxicated and also can imply keeping your mind clear.

---Be on the lookout for the enemy

I Tim 4:1-2 Now the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will depart from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and the teachings of demons, <sup>2</sup> through the hypocrisy of liars whose consciences are seared.

John 13:27 After Judas ate the piece of bread, Satan entered him. So Jesus told him, "What you're doing, do quickly."

Luke 22:31 "Simon, Simon,<sup>a</sup> look out. Satan has asked to sift you<sup>b</sup> like wheat. <sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you<sup>b</sup> that your faith may not fail. And you, when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

---Be mindful of how to handle temptations and trials.

-Stand firm against the devil.

-Remind yourself you are not alone!
