 - 1. Acts 16, 22-34 The story of the jailer in Philippi
 - 2. Must be saved-
 - Must → Meaning = essential, commanded, compelled to
- 2. "What Shall We Do"? Day of Pentecost.
 - 1. Acts 2:37-41
 - 2. "What shall we do"
 - 3. The early church committed themselves to 4 "Get To's"
 - 1. Apostles Teaching
- 2. Fellowship
- 3. Breaking of bread
- 4. Prayer
- 4. These are not "have to's". These are keys to a successful walk with Christ.
- 3. "Get to" do Good Works
 - 1. Ephesians 2:4-10 "But God"
 - 2. We are created in Christ Jesus for good works.
 - 3. What are the good works? They are the "want to's"
 - (slide) "I want to": Good works do not produce salvation, they are a product of salvation. Jesus said,"Let your light shine before others that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:15-16
 - 4. True believers are "compelled" to make a difference in someone else's life. Meet their needs. To do good works!
- 4. "What must I do" (NIV)
 - 1. Luke 18:18-30 \rightarrow The rich young ruler
 - 2. Again, the rich man was "compelled" by the presence of Jesus to do something about his lost state. He was under conviction and felt guilty for his sin.
 - 3. "Follow Me"
 - 4. Free Will God's greatest gift to mankind!
 - The rich man had a choice to make
- 5. What must "I do"?
 - 1. You choose! → Eternal life or eternal death.
