1. What MUST I do to be saved
 1. Acts 16, 22-34 – The story of the jailer in Philippi
 2. Must be saved-
 - Must → Meaning = essential, commanded, compelled to
2. “What Shall We Do”? Day of Pentecost.
 1. Acts 2:37-41
 2. “What shall we do”
 3. The early church committed themselves to 4 “Get To’s”
 1. Apostles Teaching
 2. Fellowship
 3. Breaking of bread
 4. Prayer
 4. These are not “have to’s”. These are keys to a successful walk with Christ.
3. “Get to” do Good Works
 1. Ephesians 2:4-10 – “But God”
 2. We are created in Christ Jesus for good works.
 3. What are the good works? They are the “want to’s”
(slide) “I want to”: Good works do not produce salvation, they are a product of salvation. Jesus said, “Let your light shine before others that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:15-16
 4. True believers are “compelled” to make a difference in someone else’s life. Meet their needs. To do good works!
4. “What must I do” (NIV)
 1. Luke 18:18-30 → The rich young ruler
 2. Again, the rich man was “compelled” by the presence of Jesus to do something about his lost state. He was under conviction and felt guilty for his sin.
 3. “Follow Me”
 4. Free Will – God’s greatest gift to mankind!
 - The rich man had a choice to make
5. What must “I do”?
 1. You choose! → Eternal life or eternal death.
 2. How did you answer the call to “Come follow me”?
