Philippians 1:1-11

Main Idea: As a body of believers, our local and global unity, our maturity in the faith, and our service to Christ are all initiated, sustained, and completed by God.

• As a body of believers (vv. 1,4,7,8)

-Paul wasn't writing to individuals but to the church.

• Our local and global unity

-We are united universally with every believer around the world (vv. 5,7,8)

-We are united locally with a particular body of believers (v. 6)

• Our maturity in the faith (vv. 6, 9-11)

-<u>Sanctification</u> – the process by which we are conformed to the image of Christ

-<u>Maturity</u> – growth in all areas of Christlike-ness.

• Our service to Christ (v. 5)

-Our partnership in the gospel is more than supporting mission work. It is our own ministry and evangelism.

• Initiated, Sustained, and Completed by God (vv. 5-6)

-We can trust God's promises for the future because of His work in the past and present.
