## Children in Worship

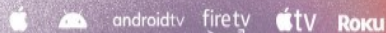
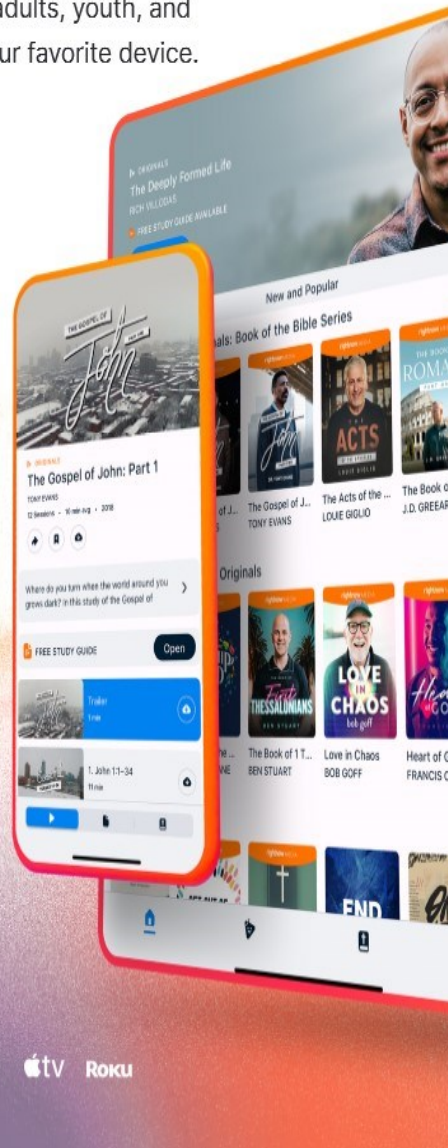
