Children in Worship

Parents, relax. Children wiggle. We understand and we're so glad you're here with your little one(s). Consider sitting near the front to see if this helps your child see and engage in the service. Explain the different parts of the service to your child (singing God's praise, listening to God's word, praying God's will, etc). Children won't understand all the words they will hear, but they understand body language. Let them learn that God is worthy of our songs, prayers, and listening ears by the way you and others around them participate. If you feel that you need to leave the worship center for a time with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back.
