God, A Self-portrait: A Study of the Parables "The Touch of Grace"

Text: Luke 7:36-50

Big Idea: The sovereign touch of grace radically transforms the most ardent sinner.

And we are reminded of its parallel truth:

Apart from the sovereign touch of grace the most righteous person is held captive by his own self-righteousness.

This passage is about the heart of the Gospel, it is about grace.

Let's examine first the life of Simon as we discover:

I. The heart untouched by grace is filled with arrogance and contempt.

Now note the contrast with the sinful woman.

II. The heart touched by the grace of God overflows with love and devotion.
