The Small Group Sermon Study Hebrews 2:1-4



Opening Prayer: Father, in Jesus' name, through the Holy Spirit, come and speak to us, teach us and transform us as we read, discuss and reflect on Your word.

Review the key points of the sermon.

- Have you ever been lost or accidentally missed important instructions? What was the result?
- What did you appreciate, or feel challenged in, about this message?

Reflect on the main points and the key passages of Scripture from the sermon.

1. The Warning (Hebrews 2:1, 3)

How have you experienced, or seen others struggle with, spiritual drifting? How is your ongoing walk with Jesus?

2. The Drift (Matthew 6:19, 21, 24, 18:15-17; Ephesians 4:26-27; Hebrews 12:15)

What are specific situations that cause drift (disasters, disappointments, distractions, broken relationships, etc.)? How does Scripture help you resist the desire to drift in these times?

3. The Price (Hebrews 2:2-3, 12:5-11)

God gives us an incredible gift of salvation and it's easy to take advantage of the love of God and His grace. What are the consequences when we drift?

4. The Recovery (Hebrews 2:4, Revelation 2:5)

What is the role of repentance and how does it invite God to rescue us?

5. The End (2 Timothy 4:2-5, 7-8)

Are there relationships and places in which God is inviting you to "do the work of an evangelist" and invite others back to God?

Personal reflection: Silently re-read the key passage(s) of Scripture from the sermon, asking the Holy Spirit to speak to you.

- What emotions does this passage, or the key theme, stir up in you? What do you need to surrender to Jesus?
- How will you respond to what God is showing you?

Prayer: Spend time praying for one another (that we would grow in our love for God and others, that we would be transformed by what God has revealed, that we would be alert and obedient to God, etc.).
