# “An Unsinkable Faith” | February 19 & 20, 2022

The Small Group Sermon Study

Hebrews 11:7



**Opening Prayer: Father, in Jesus’ name, through the Holy Spirit, come and speak to us, teach us and transform us as we read, discuss and reflect on Your word.**

1. Icebreaker Question: What faith-stretching ask (from someone else, or from God) have you experienced in your life?
2. Read the key passage(s) of Scripture from the message and review the points from the sermon notes, then discuss the following questions:
  - a. What did you learn about Noah and his story that was new for you?
  - b. Pastor Wade said, “In Noah we find an example of what obedience over understanding looks like.” When have you needed to obey even though you didn’t completely understand?
  - c. How can we as a small group encourage one another in living out this concept of obedience over understanding? And what might it require of each of us to allow our group to help us in this challenge?
  - d. In what ways is our group really doing well at growing our faith? How might we improve and do more to grow deeper in faith?
  - e. What additional questions does this passage/message raise for you? Is there anything else here that our small group can/should dig into further?

***Silently re-read the key Scripture(s) from the message, asking the Holy Spirit to speak to you.***

3. What emotions does this passage, or the key theme, stir up in you?
4. What do you need to surrender to Jesus? How will you respond to what God is showing you?
5. What verse, phrase, word or challenge do you need to take with you this week? How will you act on what you’ve heard?

*Prayer: Spend time praying for one another (that we would grow in our love for God and others, that we would be transformed by what God has revealed, that we would be alert and obedient to God, etc.).*
