Fifty-seven people died when Mount St. Helens erupted in Washington on May 18, 1980 at 8:32 a.m.

Harry Randall Truman, 83, became somewhat of a folk hero in the weeks leading up to the eruption after he refused to vacate his home near Mount St. Helens despite being urged to leave by officials.

Mr. Truman, like all of us, had the power to receive, or reject the truth. He was warned, but he rejected the warning and died. His body was never recovered. Hundreds of others received the warning and lived.

How many of you blame the authorities for sending Mr. Truman to a fire and brimstone death?

If you, or someone you know, is being tempted to question the goodness of God because of the Bible's teaching on Heaven and Hell, let's look at who's responsible for our final destination.

1. Jesus doesn't reject anybody, but everybody rejected Him.

"He came to that which was His own [that which belonged to Him—His world, His creation, His possession], and those who were His own [people—the Jewish nation] did not receive and welcome Him."

John 1:11 AMP

"He was despised and rejected— a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on Him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care."

Isaiah 53:3 NLT

2. Mankind has a long history of rejecting God.

"Throughout human history the fingerprints of God were upon them, yet they refused to honor Him as God or even be thankful for His kindness. Instead, they entertained corrupt and foolish thoughts about what God was like. This left them with nothing but misguided hearts, steeped in moral darkness."

Romans 1:21 TPT

"This is the judgment [that is, the cause for indictment, the test by which people are judged, the basis for the sentence]: the Light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil. For every wrongdoer hates the Light, and does not come to the Light [but shrinks from it] for fear that his [sinful, worthless] activities will be exposed and condemned."
