Here's a scripture about two sisters. One is in the right position to be blessed and the other has chosen the wrong position. She thinks she's where she's supposed to be and judges that her sister is not.

"As Jesus and the disciples continued on their journey, they came to a village where a woman welcomed Jesus into her home. Her name was Martha and she had a sister named Mary. Mary sat down attentively before the Master, absorbing every revelation He shared.

But Martha became exasperated by finishing the numerous household chores in preparation for her guests, so she interrupted Jesus and said, "Lord, don't you think it's unfair that my sister left me to do all the work by myself? You should tell her to get up and help me." The Lord answered her, "Martha, My beloved Martha. Why are you upset and troubled, pulled away by all these many distractions? Are they really that important? Mary has discovered the one thing most important by choosing to sit at My feet. She is undistracted, and I won't take this privilege from her."" Luke 10:38-42 TPT

1. Mary:

- -choosing the one most important thing, to sit at the Master's feet.
- -absorbing(not just listening to a sermon) every revelation He shared.
- -undistracted.

2. Martha:

- -upset and troubled.
- -pulled away and distracted by many things of lesser importance.
- 3. Which one are you? Mary, or Martha?
- 4. Each person was presented with a choice. God always gives each of us choices to position ourselves to fulfill His purpose and design for our lives.
- "Trust in and rely confidently on the LORD with all your heart And do not rely on your own insight or understanding. In all your ways know and acknowledge and recognize Him, And He will make your paths straight

and smooth [removing obstacles that block your way]."
