Week Front



Begin this time by reading the seven “I Am” statements aloud as a group:

- 1) Then Jesus declared, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” – John 6:35 (The Bread of Life)
- 2) When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” – John 8:12 (The Light of the World)
- 3) “I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture.” – John 10:9 (The Door or The Gate for the Sheep)
- 4) I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep...“I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me.” – John 10:11,14 (The Good Shepherd)
- 5) Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing

in me will never die. Do you believe this?”
– John 11:25-26 (The Resurrection and the Life)

6) Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” – John 14:6 (The Way and the Truth and the Life)

7) “I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener...I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.” – John 15:1, 5 (The True Vine)

- Which of these statements are you holding fast to this week? Which of these great truths about Jesus refreshes your heart today?

Watch Video:

As a group, watch the series video, "The Way and the Truth and the Life"

In The Word:

Read Exodus 33:12-23

- What is Moses' plea to God concerning His Presence and purpose? What is the distinguishing factor for Moses and the people of God?
- Read Exodus 33:19. What is the glory of the Lord? What does it mean that God will proclaim His name?
- Have you experienced the goodness, mercy, and compassion of the Lord in your own life?

Read John 14:1-14

- What is taking place within this passage? Why were the disciples troubled and in need of comforting? Why do you think Philip asked Jesus the question He did?
- What is the relationship between God the Father and Jesus? How does this serve as an encouragement to you this week?
- What does it mean to believe in Jesus? What does Jesus promise for those who believe in Him?

Prayer:

In the midst of doubts and questions and the circumstances, Jesus pronounces that He is the way, the truth, and the life. Pray that God would set your heart on fire with this truth and lead you into doing even greater things for His glory. Pray boldly for revival, opportunities for evangelism, holiness, and the mission of God in your life, your group, and our church.

Apply:

- Jesus is THE way, THE truth, and THE life. One can only receive salvation through Him. This week, pray boldly, expectantly, and faithfully for those you know who do not believe in Jesus. Pray for the billions worldwide who follow false gods or deny the truth about Jesus.
- This week, share the good news of Jesus with someone. Pray for your fellow group members as they do the same. This week, consider writing an encouraging letter or email to one of our missionaries, spurring them on to faithfulness in proclaiming Jesus to the ends of the earth.
