Sermon: Look at This Mess!

^{2 Chronicles 29:3-11 (NLT)} In the very first month of the first year of his reign, Hezekiah reopened the doors of the Temple of the LORD and repaired them. ⁴He summoned the priests and Levites to meet him at the courtyard east of the Temple. ⁵He said to them, "Listen to me, you Levites! Purify yourselves, and purify the Temple of the LORD, the God of your ancestors. Remove all the defiled things from the sanctuary. ⁶Our ancestors were unfaithful and did what was evil in the sight of the LORD our God. They abandoned the LORD and his dwelling place; they turned their backs on him. ⁷They also shut the doors to the Temple's entry room, and they snuffed out the lamps. They stopped burning incense and presenting burnt offerings at the sanctuary of the God of Israel.

 8 "That is why the $_{\rm LORD}$'s anger has fallen upon Judah and Jerusalem. He has made them an object of dread, horror, and ridicule, as you can see with your own eyes. 9 Because of this, our fathers have been killed in battle, and our sons and daughters and wives have been captured. 10 But now I will make a covenant with the $_{\rm LORD}$, the God of Israel, so that his fierce anger will turn away from us. 11 My sons, do not neglect your duties any longer! The $_{\rm LORD}$ has chosen you to stand in his presence, to minister to him, and to lead the people in worship and present offerings to him."

Hezekiah knows that he can't call the nation to return to God until first he has called the church to return to God!

Addressing the Debris & Defilement

1) It began when God became displaced. 2 Chron 28:24-25 ²⁴And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of Jehovah; and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem. ²⁵And in every city of Judah he made high places to burn incense unto other gods, and provoked to anger Jehovah, the God of his fathers. ¹

Addressing the Debris & Defilement

2) With God displaced, debris and defilement easily moved in.

2 Chron 19:16-17 And the priests went in unto the inner part of the house of Jehovah, to cleanse it, and brought out all the uncleanness that they found in the temple of Jehovah into the court of the house of Jehovah. And the Levites took it, to carry it out abroad to the brook Kidron. Now they began on the first day of the first month to sanctify, and on the eighth day of the month came they to the porch of Jehovah; and they sanctified the house of Jehovah in eight days: and on the sixteenth day of the first month, they made an end.

3) When the debris builds up enough you come to a point where you have one of two choices: clean it up or close it off!

2 Chronicles 29:8 Wherefore the wrath of Jehovah was upon Judah and Jerusalem, and he hath delivered them to be tossed to and fro, to be an astonishment, and a hissing, as ye see with your eyes. *For, lo, our fathers have fallen by the sword, and our sons and our daughters and our wives are in captivity for this*.
