14 So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.

Before the Beginning: God, Love, Darkness

"If God created man, each human being is then the realization of a certain divine conception AND PURPOSE! (my emphasis) Here then is the problem. The atheism of the eighteenth-century abolished God, and yet still insisted there was such a thing as human nature, that there were still some things we must do because they're good for human beings to do.

Atheistic existentialism, of which I am a representative, declares with greater consistency that if God does not exist, we must face the consequences of this. That being we are NOT made with a purpose and there is no 'priori good'. Nowhere is it written that human beings must be honest, that we must not lie, because we are now on a plane where there are only human beings and no god. As Dostoyevsky wrote, if there is no god, everything is permitted."
