## Babylon The Prostitute

Now we witness the fifth major cycle of judgments and conflict between the forces of God and those serving Satan. Babylon the prostitute appears, representing the seductions of the world. Babylon represents all worldly power opposed to Christ. This is not a literal city or place as much as the entire system of humanistic government, economics, luxury, pleasure-seeking and false worship that allures people into its deceptive web of false security. All this will be thrown down for destruction and Christ will at last make his dramatic appearance as Warrior/Judge on a white horse, to bring in the climatic END.
