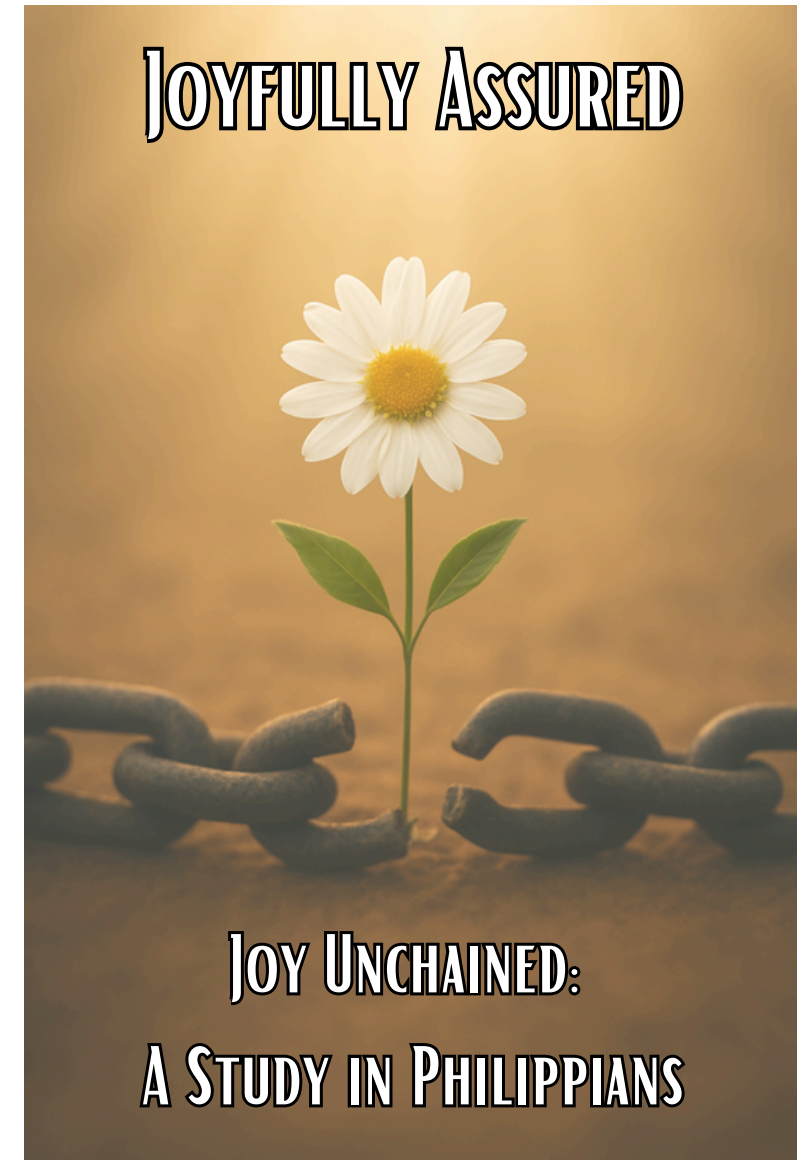

This year, our goal is to pack 400 shoeboxes, each one representing a tangible expression of God’s love and the hope of the Gospel. Collection buckets will be available at each church entrance throughout the year to receive monthly donated items. With prayerful participation, we believe we can reach—and exceed—our goal together!

Monthly Collection Focus

- January: Stuffed animals
- February: Hats (winter or summer), gloves/mittens
- March: Washcloths, reusable feminine products for teens, deodorant
- April: Combs, brushes, hair bows
- May: Balls (tennis, bouncy, moon), yo-yos, slinkies, LEGO sets, plastic animals
- June: Sunglasses, flip flops, socks
- July: Puzzles, games, interactive toys
- August: Colored pencils, markers, crayons
- September: Stickers, playdough, fishing kits, jewelry kits
- October: Bring your own family shoeboxes
- November & December: Pray

Those who prefer to participate in alternative ways may build shoeboxes online or buy bulk items from Amazon. These options help ensure consistency, allow for larger-scale participation, and support our annual fall packing party.

Families are encouraged to gather items throughout the year, creating opportunities to pray, plan, and teach children about generosity and global missions.
