Galatians 6

The book of Galatians defines the household of faith that was established by God. We learn from the Apostle Paul that we receive God's salvation through faith in Jesus Christ. As a result we live in the power of grace as we walk step by step into our purpose.

Key Scriptures: *Galatians 6: 9-10; Genesis 2: 9, 16-17; Genesis 3: 4-7; 1 Corinthians 3: 6-8; 2 Timothy 1: 5-7*

1. Describe a time you felt like giving up. (Jobs, relationship, on good habits, etc...) What motivated you to remain strong?

2. According to God, we are asked to cooperate with him in working hard but trust him to produce the harvest. Have you ever flipped this around and lived like God was supposed to work for you to produce the harvest you desired? If so, what did you learn?

3. Pastor Ryan shared several stories from families who've seen God's faithfulness in the details of their lives. Did this remind you of anything from your story where God showed his strength through your life?

Pray

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you any areas where he wants to help you grow. Invite Him into those areas and ask Him to empower you to live a surrendered life, trusting that He loves you. Pray for new thought patterns to emerge as old ways of thinking and living pass away, and ask the Lord to bring a fresh breath of air to your relationship with Him.
