SEVEN [part 7] 3 Days to Resurrection

ICEBREAKER

What are some of your favorite Easter traditions and/or memories?

This is the kind of life you've been invited into, the kind of life Christ lived. He suffered everything that came his way so you would knowthat it could be done, and also knowhowto do it, step-by-step.

1 Peter 2: 21 MSG

DISCUSSION

- 4. Pastor Ryan shared a few stories from his life. He mentioned that there was a time(s) in his life he struggled to find peace and contentment. Have you ever felt this way? What changed your mind? See *Psalm 73: 16-17*
- 5. How do you think your future will be different in light of what you've learned this Easter? How will you specifically embrace moving forward into new application of God's truth?
