The Holy Bible - Part 2 Can the Bible Be Trusted?

Overview

In this second message of our series, "The Holy Bible," Pastor Ryan continued to encourage us to devote our lives to God's Word. The Bible is not just a book, it is holy. We need to treat it as special, set-apart, and holy in our lives. If we are going to align our lives with the truth of the Bible, it's important for us to know why we believe what it says. In this message, Pastor Ryan gave us 5 reasons why we can trust the Bible:

- 1. It is historically accurate.
- 2. It is scientifically accurate.
- 3. It is prophetically accurate.
- 4. It has survived all attacks.
- 5. It has life-changing power.

If we are going to commit our lives to following Jesus, we have to commit to believing and living by His Word. Let's accept the Bible as our final authority and actively apply its truth to every area of our lives!

- 5. Pastor Ryan shared his personal testimony at the end of the message and how the Holy Bible has produced life changing power in his family. How has the Holy Bible done this in your life? Consider testifying to God's goodness in your life with the group.
