#### **Book of the Month**

#### Title: Sacred Marriage: What if God Designed Marriage to Make Us Holy More Than to Make Us Happy? Author: Gary Thomas Recommender: David Schmitt

David's Review:

I spend a lot of my time reading commentaries and books related to topics that I plan on teaching or am currently teaching. When I read a book for leisure, it



usually takes me a bit longer because I am more focused on Bible classes and sermons. But I recently began reading this book by Gary Thomas that focuses on marriage. Unlike most books that deal with marriage, this is not about making marriages better (although reading this book can make this happen) or how to make the most out of marriages, but rather to show how the marriage union mirrors our relationship with God the Father. While I have understood that many of our human relationships teach us how to have a relationship with the God who created them, I hadn't considered it to the depth and length that this author goes.

Having taught and preached on Song of Solomon, I have always viewed the marriage relationship as one that mimics the marriage of the Lamb of God, Christ Jesus, with the church. As a parent, I understand better the dynamic between God the Father and us as His children. But this author explains how the unique covenant of two Christian people brings together two imperfect people who have to learn and adapt to each other's shortcomings. Within the marriage contract comes, almost forcibly, the need to learn how to forgive each other, serve each other, and put our spouses' needs ahead of our own. That's what makes marriage so difficult. And as I read this book, I found myself thinking about how many times within my own marriage that I've had to learn these things, and have to continue to do so. The book shows how our marriage can and does teach us how to love each other, how to respect others, build our prayer life, and build Christian character, the very qualities of Biblical holiness.

I recommend this book to those who are married, even for many years, as well as those who are going to be. Those who are single may also benefit by understanding how much the marriage relationship has the opportunity to build us towards the kind of holiness that models God's ideal. As we gain a deeper understanding of the role we each play in the marriage relationship, we can begin to appreciate the blessedness of being married to Christ.

May God truly make us righteous in our human relationships and teach us how to honor our part in the covenant He has with us.
