## Eagle or Oyster?

Consider the oyster! No problems. No worries. And most of all—no hassles!

The oyster is blessed with absolute economic and social security. It never requires a home. Its home rests on its back. It requires no other defense from enemies. It simply closes the door and waits.

No work. No toil. When the oyster is hungry, it just opens up its shell and food rushes in. What a life! Complete freedom from want!

At times the life of an oyster appeals. All our wants met. No tough decisions, no sacrifice, no work. Only one thing required—open and close the shell. Everything else is provided.

But just for a moment, consider the eagle. Survival is difficult, at best. The eagle has been given no home; it must build a nest. Up high where its eggs are protected, the eagle nests amongst wind and rocks, hail and snow.

Daily the elements challenge the eagle. To eat, it must fly, search and capture. To survive, it must be strong and alert. No easy life for the eagle! Threatened daily by storms and danger, the proud bird grows tough. And independent.

By no coincidence, America chose the eagle, not the oyster, as its national symbol.

The Bible speaks of mounting up with wings like eagles, not clamming up in shells like oysters. More specifically, it says, "They who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint" (Isaiah 40:31).

The eagle may have a tough life, but it's the better for it. Our lives may even be tougher, but given a chance, God can renew our strength and enable us to mount up with wings like eagles in the face of difficulty.

God can do that—given a chance. But as the passage indicates, it happens for those who "wait for the Lord," not for those who clam up like oysters. Often, little will happen in a life closed to God's energizing power. So much can happen to those who learn to wait.
