Family Devotional

Receiving Forgiveness

Talking to God

Silently confess the things you have done that are hurtful to others. Ask God for forgiveness. Then thank Him for forgiving you.

Diving In

At your next family meal, have everyone wear earplugs or earphones but talk as usual, without trying to help each other hear what you are saying. Also wear them as you clear the table as a family.

Going Deeper

When you don't come to God to be forgiven, it is as if you refuse to listen to Him. By not hearing God, you separate yourself from Him, just as you did when you suddenly could not hear your family well. Read Psalm 32:5, "I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord'—and you forgave the guilt of my sin."

When you ask for forgiveness, God forgives you. It is as if He removes the earplugs from your ears, and you can hear Him again.

Talking to Each Other

- Have you ever kept something you did wrong a secret? If so, how did trying to hide this secret make you feel?
- What might keep you from going to God and confessing a sin?
- How do you feel when someone forgives you for something you've done wrong?

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

SERMON NOTES

The Narrow Gate

It took Michelangelo Buonarroti just over four years, from July 1508 to October 1512, to fresco the ceiling and vault of the Sistine Chapel. Initially, he was only supposed to paint the 12 Apostles, but by the end of the project, he had painted more than 300 figures.

Michelangelo had never painted frescoes before and was learning the craft as he worked. He did have some help from assistants who mixed the plaster, ground the pigments, moved the scaffolding, and aligned the cartoons. Michelangelo and his team spent long hours standing upright on makeshift scaffolding and platforms, constantly shifting them to reach more ceiling space. Michelangelo once called painting “torture.”

For most people, other than maybe a history buff, no one really cares about how long the painting took but rather is more concerned with the final result. Most people would not care if he put in a lot of effort into it if it turned out ugly. In business, they call this “The Bottom Line.” In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus calls this bottom line “The fruit of a person’s work.” As we close our series on the Sermon on the Mount, we look at Jesus’ parting thoughts, including how to identify a person living in the Kingdom and the choice that this most famous of sermons presents to all of us.

Questions for Reflection:

1. What has been the most challenging teaching from the Sermon on the Mount for you?
2. How do we judge the “fruit” of those who teach us? In what sense do we need to be careful as we do this?
3. What baggage is most challenging for you to give up? What are some practical steps you can take to remove it from your life?
4. Who can you ask to help hold you accountable for living your life in a way that more resembles the teachings of the Sermon on the Mount? What changes in your life is the Sermon on the Mount calling you to make?

Notas Del Sermon - La Puerta Estrecha

Le toco a Miguel Ángel Buonarroti más de cuatro años, desde Julio de 1508 hasta Octubre de 1512, en hacer un fresco en el techo y la bóveda de la Capilla Sixtina. Inicialmente se suponía que solo debía pintar a los 12 Apóstoles, pero al final del proyecto, había pintado más de 300 figuras. Miguel Ángel nunca había pintado frescos antes y estaba aprendiendo el oficio mientras trabajaba. Contó con la ayuda de los asistentes, que mezclaron el yeso, molieron los pigmentos, movieron el andamio y alinearon los dibujos. Miguel Ángel y su equipo pasaron largas horas de pie en andamios y plataformas improvisados, moviéndolos constantemente para alcanzar más espacio en el techo. Miguel Ángel una vez llamó a la pintura "tortura".

Para la mayoría de las personas, aparte de tal vez un aficionado a la historia, a nadie le importa realmente cuánto tiempo tardó en pintar, sino estaban más preocupado por el resultado final. A la mayoría de la gente no le importaría si el puso muchos esfuerzos y resultara que quedo feo. En los negocios, llaman a esto "El Resultado Final", en el sermón el Monte, Jesús llama a este, "El fruto de la obra de una persona". Al cerrar nuestra serie sobre el Sermón de la Monte, miramos los pensamientos de partida de Jesús, incluyendo cómo identificar a una persona que vive en el Reino, y la elección que este más famoso de los sermones nos presenta a todos.

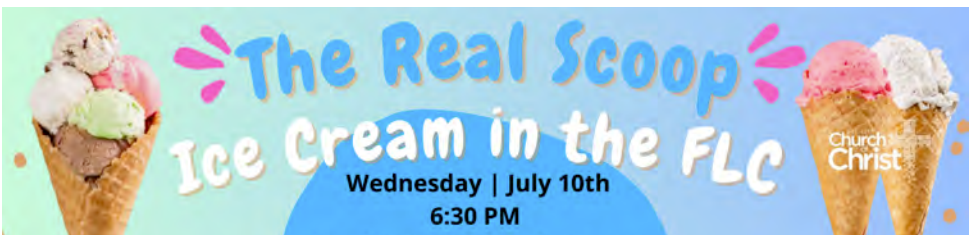
