When Wisdom Speaks

Opening Reflection

Prompt:.....

1. What comes to mind when you hear the word wisdom?
2. Is wisdom more about knowing, doing, or timing?

Scripture Meditation: Read Ecclesiastes 8:1 aloud.

3. “Who is like the wise? Who knows the explanation of things
• Invite the group to sit with the tension: wisdom is radiant, but not always sufficient.

Wisdom and Authority | Text: Ecclesiastes 8:2–5

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean to “not be hasty to leave the king’s presence”?
2. How do we discern when to speak truth to power versus when to wait?
3. Have you ever felt called to challenge authority in a godly way?
4. What helped you act—or held you back?

Cross-Reference:

- Exodus 5:1–2 — Moses before Pharaoh
 - Esther 4:12–17 — Esther before the king
5. What do these stories teach us about courage, timing, and divine prompting?

The Limits of Wisdom | Text Ecclesiastes 8:6–9

Discussion Questions:

1. What does this passage say about the unpredictability of life and justice?
2. How do we respond when wisdom doesn’t “fix” the situation?
3. How do we avoid idolizing wisdom as a substitute for trust in God?

Cross-Reference:

- James 3:13–18 — Wisdom from above vs. earthly wisdom
 - Proverbs 8 — Wisdom personified as calling out in the streets
4. How do these passages deepen our understanding of wisdom’s role and character?

Application and Prayer

Reflection Questions:.....

1. Where in your life might God be calling you to speak wisely and courageously?
2. Is there a situation where you’ve been silent out of fear or uncertainty?
3. What would it look like to “stand in the gap” with humility and love?

Prayer Focus:.....

- Ask God for discernment, courage, and compassion.
- Pray for those in positions of authority and those called to counsel them.

When Wisdom Speaks

Wisdom is radiant—but it's not passive. In Ecclesiastes 8, the Teacher challenges us to consider when and how wisdom must be used to speak truth, even to power. Through the stories of Moses and Esther, we'll explore what it means to stand in the presence of authority, not hastily retreat, and lovingly guide others away from destruction. This sermon invites us to wrestle with courage, timing, and the call to intervene—not out of pride, but out of love.
