EDITORIAL

Abundant Living

One of my all time favorite Bible verses is found in John 10:10, "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly." This verse has suffered much abuse throughout the ages. Men have tried to make it have a "health, wealth and happiness" meaning. But this has only frustrated many good, godly people who never experience wealth and do experience failing health. It has caused some to despair, thinking, "I have tried to live for Jesus, yet all I seem to experience is problems and anxiety. Where is the abundant life in all of that?" Good question. Bad theology.

I have not always understood what Jesus was talking about. I have fallen into the trap of wondering how a bad circumstance could be interpreted as abundant living; until, that is, I dug a little deeper.

There are two terms for *life* used in the *Koiné Greek* language, in which the New Testament was first penned. One is $\zeta\omega\dot{\eta}$ ($z\bar{o}$ -ay) and the other is $\beta i\sigma \sigma$ ($b\bar{\imath}$ - $\bar{o}s$). $Bi\sigma is$ a word that specifically refers to animal life. It is talking about the period, means and manner of existence. This is life in the here and now with no reference to or concern with what happens after death. This is the word that the apostle John uses in 1 John 2:16, *"the pride of life."* Whenever we allow ourselves to become

discouraged because we don't feel like God is blessing us with abundant life, what we really mean is abundant β (o σ . This is your carnal, fleshly, selfish way of thinking. This is one of the avenues that gets us into sin.

Here is a newsflash: Jesus NEVER promised abundant β (α); He did promise abundant ζ α $\dot{\eta}$. Z α $\dot{\eta}$ is the term used in John 10:10 and it means eternal life. It is that part of you and me that is designed to live forever. And

what Jesus is promising is that those who hope and trust in Him through obedience to His Word are going to receive eternal life, not just barely, but abundantly! Life in the hereafter, for those who are saved, will be greater than any mind can imagine, and it will be so abundant that it will never run out. Life on this earth ($\beta(i\sigma\sigma)$) will end, sometimes all too soon. But real life, life indeed, life in the presence of your Creator ($\zeta\omega\dot{\eta}$) will never end. The antithesis of abundant $\zeta\omega\dot{\eta}$ is abundant death. Those who are not prepared for this never-ending life will experience never-ending death.

Let me tell you what this truth does for me. As I walk through life on earth, there are good days and bad, valley days and rough seas. When I incorrectly believe that Jesus promised me a bed of roses, health and wealth and nothing but happiness, then my faith cracks and sometimes crumbles when life is everything but that. But when I correctly understand that life on earth is simply that, a cheap imitation of the real thing, then I expect problems to come. And it is my hope of properly defined abundant living that can keep me going through any kind of unpleasant circumstance. Jesus came to offer abundant living $(\zeta \omega \acute{\eta}).$ Set your hope on that!
