## SERMON NOTES

### Victorious Living: The Sin that Lost the Battle Joshua 6:17-18; 7:1-26

Israel ultimately won the victory of the Promised Land, but they were not always victorious. They won the war, but they lost some battles. As disciples of Jesus, spiritual victory is already ours; but we still lose some battles to the devil. How could this happen? How could we be defeated? We are part of God's chosen people; this isn't supposed to happen to us. But it does. Let's learn from the lost battle at Ai and discover how to overcome defeat.

## EDITORIAL

### Christmas Store 2022

The Christmas Store Ministry began several years ago as a way to serve many of the under-served families in our community. Under the leadership of Susan Corbeil, it has literally become an opportunity to take a potentially stressful time for struggling families and remove that stress in the name of Jesus Christ.

The Christmas Store gives parents and family members the opportunity to give children presents they otherwise may not be able to afford. The gifts are all new, never opened toys and other items.

Parents or other family members sign up to complete 6 hours of community service. The community service can be completed in any number of places — churches, the children’s schools, food pantry, and so on. They are then able to pick out 3-4 gifts per child for whom they are shopping. They get to pick out gifts such as bicycles, Legos, bedding sets, dolls, stuffed animals, Nerf toys, action figures, electronics, jewelry, games and art supplies.

We have never turned away anyone who has not been able to complete their community service hours. However, the volunteer work they do complete gives the adults the opportunity to serve their community and have the feeling that they have earned the opportunity to shop in our Christmas store and it wasn’t just a hand-out. Last year we served 202 children and expect to serve even more this year.

There are many ways you can help this year. We always need monetary donations. So today, we will provide a special giving opportunity for you to make a direct financial donation to this ministry. We also need volunteers to serve as Shopping Assistants and Gift Wrapping Assistants. The dates for this year’s Christmas Store are November 28—December 2. We could use 4-8 volunteers per day. If you would like to volunteer for a specific day and time, look for a sign up sheet at Connection Point, or contact the church office directly in person or by phone at (405) 672-1311.

This is a great way to be the Hands and Feet of Jesus in the life of a child.
