# Victorious Living: Ingredients of a Successful Faith Joshua 5:13—6:20

The book of Joshua is a dynamic illustration of the victorious living that disciples of Jesus **SHOULD** enjoy. The first obstacle to victory for Joshua was Jericho. But by faith the walls of Jericho fell down (Hebrews 11:30). A Jericho stands between you and victorious living in Jesus. God gives the victory not by fighting, but by faith. Notice four ingredients of a successful faith from the story of Jericho.

#### **EDITORIAL**

## **The Humanity of Christ**

"Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Hebrews 4:14-15).

Some people deny the deity of Christ. Then there are others who deny His humanity. We forget His human side. And when we do, we fail to realize there is strength to be drawn from that fact.

As a man, Jesus was tempted *in every respect* that we are. Certainly He did not yield to temptation, but He was tempted just like you and me. Do we really believe that? Do you? Galatians 5:19-21 lists fifteen works of the flesh by which we are tempted:

Fornication	Enmity	Dissension
Impurity	Strife	Party Spirit
Licentiousness	Jealousy	Envy
Idolatry	Anger	Drunkenness
Sorcery	Selfishness	Carousing

Was Christ tempted by all these things? Was He tempted to lust after a woman? Was He tempted to murder? Was He tempted to rebel against His Father's will? If Hebrews 4:15 means what it says, He was. Did He sin? Certainly not! But He did experience the temptations.

"But I thought the only temptations of Christ occurred in the wilderness just before he began His ministry! He was only tempted by independence, idolatry and pride." That is just not true, for Luke records, "And when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time" (Luke 4:13). Satan never gave up trying to make Jesus fall. Jesus was truly tempted just as we are.

This is why Jesus is our perfect high priest, for, in addition to being deity, He was completely human. He is totally sympathetic with our weaknesses because He has experienced how powerful they can be. Even now He retains His humanity. "For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 2:5). From this great truth I find great comfort. For it is this sympathetic God-man who stands before God daily and pleads my case for the removal of my sins. I am so glad He never gave in to sin. He is truly the "pioneer and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2).

He is our champion, and we can look to Him for strength, guidance, mercy, grace, love and comfort. He has faced that evil slanderer who makes me fall daily, and beaten him. Thank you, Lord, for not giving in to temptation, and thank you for being sympathetic when I do.
