Come Grow Old With Me

A white headed couple walking side by side together. What a precious sight, knowing that the years are etched upon their faces! The children have grown up under their watchful care and now are gone. The mortgage is paid. The decades have faded into the distance, winnowing away their youth. She is cradled in his heart. He is her strength and assurance.

The years have blown their winds of turmoil. They have weathered the early years of struggle and adapting. They have turned their arguments into their own personal little jokes. He knows where to pick and how much is too far. She knows how to respond in her own tart but gentle way.

As they have learned to build and overcome together, they have discovered the hidden secret of the ages. Time heals. Every hurt endured, every fault overlooked, every compassion given, every courtesy shown, every quarrel resolved is all a part of growing toward one another.

Their only regret is that they couldn't have learned these little lessons sooner. If they could have had this understanding when they were younger. But, no. It was the learning of thin, through ups and their lessons by trial and error that gained for them this wisdom.

Together they could give much advice to a younger generation bent on taking without giving. Few would listen. But, those who would give an ear to their words would hear them say, "Stay together. Through thick and

The poet has said that the real reward of life is for a young man and a young woman to say one to another early in life, "Come and grow old with me."
