EDITORIAL

D-E-A-T-H

Death is not a pleasant thought, but it is an integral part of life. The human race is terminal. None of us is getting out of this world alive. And occasionally we all have one of those experiences in life which brings us face to face with the reality of death. The recent deaths of Sonya Weaver's mom, Charlyn Johnson, and John Randolph's son, John Randolph III, are such experiences. This past week, on October 5, was the 17th anniversary of my own mother's death.

The reality of death forces us to reflect on the *important* issues of life—what is it that is really lasting, what really matters. As macabre as death may be, for the believer it is really a good thing. Death is the only way any of us will ever get to see Heaven: death is the doorway to get there. It is the great irony of life. In order to live forever we must die. Consider five observations about death from the word death itself. Grab your Bible and look up the Scriptures referenced.

"D" stands for disillusion. Death is a very disillusioning experience. It often causes fear and confusion. It brings up a lot of "Why?" questions and causes normally logical people to lose their sense of reality and direction. The truth is, until the coming of Jesus Christ, no one really understood "After death, then what?" But 1 Corinthians 15 reveals that death is like the planting of a seed and it is only through death that real life can begin. This knowledge gives us strength to

press on steadfastly, immovable, always doing the work of the Lord.

"E" is for eternity. Death is when eternity begins for humanity. Life on earth can seem to drag on, especially when you are young. But the older you get, the more you realize how fleeting it is (James 4:14). We spend our lives and they expire. Eternity can never be spent. It is from now on. The question is where will you live it? Heaven or Hell? We get to choose.

"A" is for all. All of us must die (Hebrews 9:27). So we should live each Death is the only way any of us will ever get to see Heaven (unless Jesus comes first): death is the doorway to get there. It is the great irony of life. In order to live forever we must die

day to the fullest with the commitment to do what we do only "if it is the Lord's will" (James 4:14-17).

"T" is for too late. You've heard, "it's too late to pray." When our eyes close in death, it is too late. Too late to right those wrongs and say "I love you." Too late to write those letters and make those visits. Too late to help the helpless, befriend the friendless. Too late to repent and be baptized for forgiveness of your sins. When we die, our destiny is determined. While you still live, now is the day of salvation (2 Corinthians 6:2).

"H" is for Heaven or Hell. Your spirit will know immediately upon death where you will live eternally. The final judgment and sentencing will be later (2 Corinthians 5:10), but death seals it. No more appeals. No second chances. There's no such thing as Purgatory. To accept and obey Jesus now means Heaven. To reject and disobey Him means Hell (John 12:48). Which have you chosen? Which would you prefer? What will you do about it? And when are you going to do it?
