Ministry & Maintenance Report 2023

- 1. You gave \$815,972.09 averaging \$15,691.77 per week.
- 2. Twenty precious souls were baptized into Jesus Christ.
- 3. Twenty-Three new people placed membership with us.
- 4. Six of our members went to be with Jesus, which is where we all hope to be one day!
- 5. We enjoyed a wide variety of ministries serving at full capacity such as: Community Cupboard, Football Team Meals, DCYG, Easter in the Park, VBS, Camp Rock Creek, Day Camp, Whiz Kids, Fall Festival, Ladies Bible Study, Women's Conference, Community Cup, Wednesday Night Meals, Mission Sunday, Meals on Wheels, Community Garden, Visitation, Summer Nights of Service, Community Cookouts, Acappella Concert.
- 6. Community Cupboard served a total of 1079 families consisting of 897 adults and 571 children, averaging right at 90 families per month (122 people per month).
- 7. Meals on Wheels served at least 12,209 meals to the community.
- 8. We fed around 50 hungry football players and coaches before every Del City High School home game, forming solid relationships with the players.
- 9. The Christmas Store ministry served 26 families and 98 children.
- 10. Summer Nights of Service did yard work, fed homeless, aided the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma, visited newcomers to the community, made blankets.
- 11. We supported 21 missions outside of our own members mission efforts. We also supported 2 of our own members on missions they went on.
- 12. We supported Children's homes with \$18,500.00.
- 13. We made repairs and updates to the campus including new air conditioning units and new plumbing in the Family Life Center.
- 14. We added an Evangelist on our staff to assist us in our mission to focus on saving the lost.
- 15. We acquired a handicap-accessible bus to facilitate transportation for our elderly members. Additionally, we initiated the construction of a garage to house our vehicles.
