EDITORIAL

When Should I Be Baptized?

There is no magic age set forth in the Scriptures as to the right time to be baptized. Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3). From that statement, one could conclude that children have no need of baptism. Jesus was referring to the innocence of a child. In their innocence, they are safe. Until a child has the ability to learn and distinguish between right and wrong morally, innocence prevails. However, there comes a point in time when a person can discern right from wrong and grasp the concept of spirituality and eternity. A person who wants to please God and be saved for eternity should submit to baptism when they can comply to the following:

- 1. Know what is right. "So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin" (James 4:17).
- 2. Know what it means to be a sinner. "10 None is righteous, no, not one...23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:10, 23). "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).
- 3. Capable of believing that Jesus is the Son of God. "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned" (Mark 16:16).
- 4. Ready and willing to repent of (turn away from) a life of sin and commit that life to Jesus Christ. "No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3). "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God" (Luke 9:62).
- 5. Ready to confess Jesus before others and confess Jesus as Lord. "So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 10:32). "Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God" (1 John 4:15). "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Sometimes people allow their religious heritage to prevent them from doing the next right thing in their spiritual journey. The concern is that grandparents or parents may not have complied with the Scripture's instructions concerning baptism. Your obedience to what you know is the truth should not be regulated by what anyone else has or has not done. Your obedience isn't an indictment against any loved one who has died before you. Most likely, your loved ones did the best they knew to do. We must rely on the grace and mercy of God to fill in any gaps for them, as we expect for ourselves. However, we must act upon the knowledge we have from the Word of God. And any loved ones who have preceded us in death would want us to do the same thing.

The only question left is are you saved? Based upon what you have read from the Word of God, what must you do now? If you were to die today, do you know without any doubts where you would live for eternity? What are you waiting for?

SERMON NOTES

Eyewitness Good News: Quieting Spiritual Tachycardia 1 John 3:19-24

Some folks suffer from *tachycardia*, sometimes also known as *tachycardia arrhythmia*, which is a fast unregulated heartbeat. It can be a frightening experience which can be worsened by fear and anxiety. There is also something I call *spiritual tachycardia* which is when your spiritual heart begins to run away uncontrollably. Guilt, fear and anxiety bring this on. John gives us a three-ingredient prescription which will quiet your *spiritual tachycardia*.
