

The plan comes with videos that help explain the passage in depth, as well as a reading, and an area for note taking.

The purpose of this activity is 2-fold. First, it helps us as a congregation commit to investing time in the Word of God. As Christians, if we believe that God has spoken to us through His Word, we should want to learn it as best we can, probe its infinite depths with study, and come away blessed, over and over again.

The second purpose, is we will be doing this TOGETHER. We can take encouragement that this church family will be reading the same passages of scripture every week, possibly have the same questions, wrestling with the same topics, and can talk with one another about what we are reading. This not only helps strengthen our fellowship (Koinonia) but also helps keep us accountable and on track to continue being in God's Word.

The plan officially kicks off Jan. 14 (next Sunday) but no harm in getting ahead!

## "Wrestling With God"

In Genesis 32, we find a very unusual story. Jacob, on the eve of meeting his estranged brother Esau for the first time since he had tricked his way into getting his blessing, goes off to be by himself. It is at this point a strange man comes upon him, and they begin to wrestle. At the end of this wrestling match, we are told that this stranger is none other than God, and He changes Jacob's name and blesses Him.

What are we to make of this passage? Is this just one of those weird stories from the Bible that just happens, we learn about, and move on? Or, maybe this story, like all the Bible, has an incredible spiritual truth just waiting to be discovered so it can change how we see, and interact, with the creator of the Universe.
