

## **EDITORIAL**

## **Handling Stress**

There is a story about a man who walked backward across the United States. He started in California and ended in New York. At the end of his journey, someone asked, "What was the hardest part of your trip? What was the single most difficult thing? Was it the desert, or the mountains, or the rivers?"

"No," the man answered. "It was the sand in my shoes."

Little worries, nagging anxieties, frustrating annoyances can destroy us. We seem to handle the big concerns pretty well, but the little worries are the sand in our shoes. There is a lot of wisdom in this prayer: "Lord, we can handle the elephants, but please deliver us from these gnats."

Henry Emerson Fosdick described the ruin of a gigantic tree on the slope of Long's Peak in Colorado. Naturalists estimated it has stood for some 400 years. It was a seedling when Columbus arrived in San Salvador; it was half grown when the pilgrims settled in Plymouth. During the course of its long life, it had been struck by lightning fourteen times and innumerable avalanches and storms had hit it, lashed it and thundered past it. In the end, however, it fell. Why? Because an army of tiny beetles ate their way through the bark and gradually destroyed the tree with their incessant attacks. A forest giant which age could not wither, lightning could not blast, and storms could not subdue, fell at last before beetles so small you could crush them with your finger.

What's the irritant in your life? What pressures, worries, resentments gnaw away and devastate us from within? What can we do? How do we cope?

**Travel light**. Decide what is really important and give your energy to those things. We can't do everything, so we must decide what really matters and weed out the rest.

Take one step at a time. Do one thing at a time. Live one day at a time. A clock figured out it would have to tick more than 31 million times in one year. Overwhelmed by that thought, the clock just quit. Until someone reminded it that it didn't need to tick them all at oncejust one tick at a time. Jesus said, "Don't worry about tomorrow, live one day at a time."

**Relax your soul in God**. The idea is to sow the seed the best you can and trust God to bring in the harvest. No matter how bleak the outlook, how hopeless the odds, how stacked the deck, just sow the seed and leave the rest to God. When life gets stressful, we get better by leaning on Him.
