Has bitterness ever engulfed your soul? Someone wrongs you, you dwell on it until finally you are so miserable you don't know what to do. That's the price of bitterness: misery.

The enemy feels no pain. He or she is living rent-free in your head controlling how you feel and determining your outlook on life. The only one in pain is you. Amazingly it is really self-inflicted. We don't have to become bitter. It is a choice.

You can choose to forgive. You can choose to entrust the matter to God who judges all people justly. That is exactly what Jesus did. "When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten; but he trusted to him who judges justly" (1 Peter 2:23). While hanging on the cross after having experienced the slaps and slurs, insults and indecencies, tortures and trauma, Jesus simply said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34). Jesus chose not to become bitter. You can, too.

Someone has said, "It is not the size of the bump but the attitude of the bumpee which determines whether he is made bitter or better." I believe there is wisdom in those words. Choose not to pay the price of bitterness in your life.
