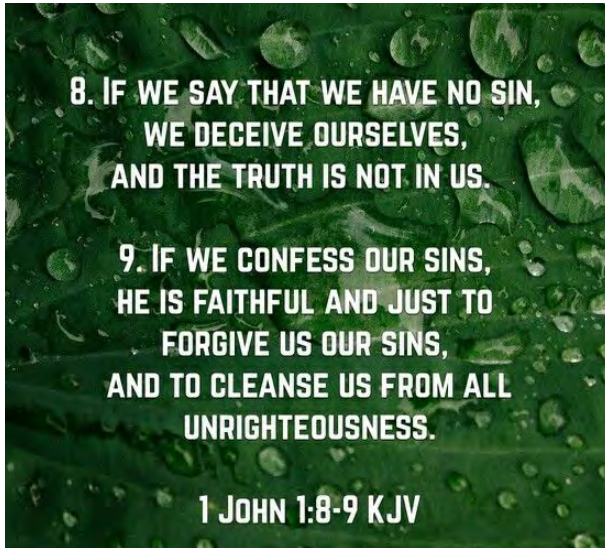

Why We Need to Confess

As John Dewey once exclaimed, “A problem well-put is half solved.”

For us to fix something, we must understand what is wrong and what is causing the problem. Too many times we face an issue and are unable—or maybe better said, unwilling—to examine ourselves to see what is wrong and we could be part of the problem.



That is what makes 1 John 1:8-9 so poignant: “If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

It’s not that God isn’t willing and able to forgive. It’s not that he is demanding a penance by making us grovel. Instead, he’s wanting and waiting for us to see the problem and see our role in its cause. If we don’t look at the root of what is going on, we will never truly be fixed.

Confession is good for the soul, but it is also needed for the mind. Until we see our sin, we will never find the way to fix it.
