SERMON NOTES

Treasure In Heaven

Commentator William Barclay tells the following story of the Early Church in Rome during the Decian persecution of AD 250:136

"The Early Church always lovingly cared for the poor, and the sick, and the distressed, and the helpless, and those for whom no one else cared. In the days of the terrible Decian persecution in Rome, the Roman authorities broke into a Christian Church. They were out to loot the treasures which they believed the Church to possess. The Roman prefect demanded from Laurentius, the deacon: "Show me your treasures at once." Laurentius pointed at the widows and orphans who were being fed, the sick who were being nursed, the poor whose needs were being supplied, "These," he said, "are the treasures of the Church."

Would you say this is the current mindset of the church today? Or your mindset personally? This morning we tackle one of Jesus' most challenging teachings yet, and it all begins with the question; What is your relationship with money?

Notas Del Sermon - Tesoro En El Cielo

El comentarista William Barclay cuenta la siguiente historia de la Iglesia primitiva en Roma durante la persecución de Decianos de 250:136 d. C.

"La Iglesia primitiva siempre cuidó con amor a los pobres, a los enfermos, a los angustiados, a los indefensos, y a aquellos a los que nadie se preocupaba. En los días de la terrible persecución de Decianos en Roma, las autoridades romanas irrumpieron en una iglesia cristiana. Estaban fuera para saquear los tesoros que creían que poseía la Iglesia. El prefecto romano le exigió a Laurentius, el diácono: "Muéstrame tus tesoros a la vez". Laurentius señaló a las viudas y huérfanos que les estaban siendo alimentados, a los enfermos que estaban siendo amantados, a los pobres cuyas necesidades estaban siendo abastecidas: "Estos", dijo, "son los tesoros de la Iglesia".

¿Dirías que esta es la mentalidad actual de la iglesia hoy en día? ¿O tu mentalidad personal? Esta mañana abordamos una de las enseñanzas más desafiantes de Jesús hasta la fecha, y todo comienza con la pregunta: ¿Cuál es tu relación con el dinero?

Yearning for God

Talking to God

Thank God that He loves you and wants you to learn to talk to Him through prayer. Ask God to teach you how to pray.

Diving In

Make three sets of note cards with the following words/phrases on them: grandparent, best friend, your favorite minister (Garrett obviously), grocery store cashier and your next door neighbors. Spread out the first stack according to the person you talk to most at the top and the person you talk to the least at the bottom. Arrange the second set in the same way, with the person you most want to be around at the top. Line the third set next to the other two, with the person you most miss at the top. Compare how similar your lists are.

Going Deeper

Prayer is simply talking to God, who loves you and wants what is best for you. Just as you may miss someone you love when he is gone, your spirit misses God when you do not spend time talking to Him. The Bible often says that this longing to be with God is like being thirsty or hungry. Read *Psalm 42:1-2: "As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God?"* You can go to God in prayer and find Him, just as the deer finds water in a stream when it is thirsty.

- How might you tell your spirit is thirsty to be with God?
