Family Devotional

A Peaceful Home

Talking to God

Ask God for forgiveness if you've hurt the feelings of someone in your family or have been unkind. Then thank God for your relationships with your family and friends.

Diving In

Use bright colors to draw a picture of a home with sunshine and birds outside and with cake, presents and a family inside. Then use dark colors to draw a second home with storm clouds and lightning outside and siblings upset with each other on the inside. Compare the pictures. Talk about why one is more peaceful.

Going Deeper

Families are made up of people with different personalities and emotions. Sometimes family members feel happy, and other times they feel angry. How a person is feeling should not change a family's peaceful home. **Romans 12:18 says, "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."** This mention of everyone includes the members of your family. Getting along with those in your family may seem like a lot of work some days. But *Proverbs 17:1* says that a peaceful home is a true treasure, something worth working for. "Better a dry crust with peace and quiet than a house full of feasting, with strife."

Talking to Each Other

- *How should you act toward family members?*
- *What can you do to be a peacemaker in the family when someone is angry or upset?*
- *How can God's peace fill your home, even when you disagree with each other?*

Fulfilled

Given my smaller stature, there were many games of athletic prowess that were, shall we say, more difficult for me than perhaps the average person. However, one game I always enjoyed, was the game of limbo.

If you are unfamiliar with the game, it is a very simple one. Two people get on either side of a stick or bar, hold it in the air and see who can go under it. As the game progresses, the bar goes lower and lower until only one can make it under, and they are the winner. I must admit, there were many times you could not wipe the smile off my face as people who were usually so dominant in feats of physical skill struggled to bend and twist to get under the stick that I could so easily just walk under.

I bring this up, because this analogy works well when describing what the Pharisees were doing with the old law. They were interpreting it in a way that it made it easier to accomplish for them, basically defining it all by what you could show on the outside. In our next section of the **Sermon on the Mount**, Jesus challenges this. More importantly, Jesus says this new way of viewing the law is *not an attempt to get rid of it, but to fulfill it*. This morning, let's see what he means by this, and what it looks like for us.

Reflection and Discussion Questions

1. Coming into this study, how have you viewed the Old Testament? Is Jesus' description of the Old Testament and its importance surprising to you at all?
2. Is it ever appropriate for us to be angry? Explain.
3. We are not supposed to literally tear out our eyes or cut off our hands; what are some "extreme" things we can do to help protect us from lust?

Esta mañana, veamos qué quiere decir con esto y cómo nos parece a nosotros.
